Certificate in Fundamental Inspection, Testing and Initial Verification BS 7671: 2008 City & Guilds 2392-10



“Gain the knowledge and skills to verify, test and certificate electrical installations”

This qualification has been developed jointly by the NICEIC and City and Guilds and is intended to provide delegates with an understanding of the fundamentals of inspection, testing and initial verification of electrical installations, as well as practical training in the use of test equipment.

All individuals attending this course must hold a 17th Edition Wiring Regulations Certificate.

The qualification is primarily aimed at practicing electricians who have not carried out regular inspection and testing since qualifying or who require some further training.

It is also suitable for those coming into the industry with some limited experience of inspection and testing.

For anyone involved in installing and testing industrial and commercial electrical installations, this City and Guilds qualification is a requirement under the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989. This states that “all electricians who are involved in the installation of industrial and commercial installations be deemed as competent and hold this qualification”.

COURSE CONTENT

- Requirements for Initial Verification and initial inspection and testing of an installation
- Statutory and non-statutory requirements
- Compliance with statutory and non-statutory requirements
- Electrical Installation Certificate and Minor Electrical Installation Works Certificate recording
- Testing

Practical Training:

- Selection of correct Test equipment to carry out functional electrical testing
- Initial Verification, inspection, testing and certification of an installation to BS 7671:2008
- Completion of Electrical Installation Certificate (as given in BS 7671 or Guidance Note 3), including the Schedule of Test Results
- Final inspection of installation components and completion of Schedule of Inspections.

Please note: Examinations are carried out using the GOLLA “on line” testing system plus a further practical assessment which is arranged with you when you book your course. It is recommended that all Delegates obtain a copy of Guidance note 3.
